Investment Objective

This portfolio is designed for the investor seeking a balanced approach to capital appreciation and portfolio stability. Investors have significant exposure to equity holdings with a small allocation to alternative asset classes but seek to eliminate some of the short-term volatility by adding a portion of fixed-income investments. This portfolio is intended for investors with a 10-20 year time horizon.

Investment Strategy

Maintain highly diversified portfolios to provide downside protection during a "trading range" market environment. Overweight domestic large cap multinational equities. Maintain positions in international equities to provide downside protection. Maintain positions in fast growing, emerging markets. Maintain low effective fixed income duration. Emphasize fixed income quality and liquidity. Maintain Treasury Inflation Protected (TIPS) position for inflation protection. Our strategy leads to a well-diversified portfolio providing consistent performance over time.

Principal Risks

The Model may hold mid- and small-capitalization investments, which presents additional risk. 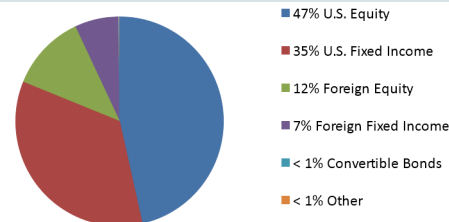
